## 2010 AFRICA HIGH LEVEL COACHES COURSE

In view of improving the level of our sport in our continent, BCA is organizing a high level Coaches Course in Mauritius Wednesday 28 to Saturday 31 July 2010, prior to the start of the 2010 Under 15 championship.

The course will be run by two BCA continental experts. It will be a high-level one, unparalleled in quality, offering intensive course instruction and modern coaching techniques for African coaches. Local players will be used for the practical side of the course, participant coaches will have to coach them in front of the instructors. Successful coaches will be graded as BCA accredited coach.

Each BCA member can nominate one coach to participate in the course. During the course, 28-31 July (four nights), the cost of full board accommodation twin sharing and the course expenses will be paid by BCA. Prior arrival and late departures will be at the charge of participants at the rate of US\$ 45 per person per day full board twin sharing. Participants will be accommodated full board (twin sharing) at Monaco Hotel, the same hotel will be used by participants for the Under 15 Championship. Member Associations willing to send more than one coach will have to pay all the cost of their additional coaches at the rate of US\$ 55 per person per day. The acceptance of the additional coach is subject to the final number of applications received.

BCA will give a travel grant of around 50% of the airfare up to a maximum of US\$ 500 for one coach per country. This grant will be based on the cheapest economy class airfare. Receipt of air tickets payments must be submitted to BCA. The grant will only be paid after the course by bank transfer to the bank account of the Member Association.

Profile of participants: He/she must be someone who is already serving badminton in his/her country and is already involved in coaching work or is a retired player, is in the age group of 30-50 years. There must be a written commitment between the participant and his/her Member Association that after following this course he/she will work for the development of badminton locally for at least 2 years. There must also be a clause stipulating that in case the participant do not respect his/her commitment to help the development of badminton locally for the two years following the course, he/she will have to refund his/her Association the equivalent of US\$ 2,000/-. Copy of this agreement must be brought by the participant in Mauritius. Dedicated participants will be invited to follow a refresher course in 2012.

Member Association must have paid the 2010 BCA subscription fees for their participants to be accepted. Applications must be made by the MA's of the coach to the Secretary General at latest by Thursday 15 July 2010. If you need any additional information, don't hesitate to contact us.
